Ed Stetzer, Ph.D., is the Dean of Talbot School of Theology at Biola University and Scholar in Residence & Teaching Pastor at Mariners Church. Dr. Stetzer has planted, revitalized, and pastored churches; trained pastors and church planters on six continents; earned two master's degrees and two doctorates; and he has written hundreds of articles and a dozen books. His latest book, *Christians in the Age of Outrage*, addresses how the church can share the love of Jesus in the midst of all the shouting and division.

Additionally, Dr. Stetzer serves as Regional Director for Lausanne North America, Editor-in-Chief of Outreach Magazine, and regularly writes for news outlets such as USA Today and CNN. Stetzer is also a contributing editor for Christianity Today and executive editor for The Gospel Project, a Bible study curriculum used by more than one million people each week.
